AN ITALIAN NEOCLASSICAL CARVED GILTWOOD CONSOLE TABLE WITH A CARRARA MARBLE TOP LOMBARDY, LATE 18TH CENTURY

The rectangular marble top inset into a molded border, the apron with an acanthus leaf frieze centered by a cartouche with a mercury mask issuing garlands and rinceaux, raised on sectioned square fluted column and round foliate carved legs, headed by lion masks and ending in toupie feet.
